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## **DONALD TRUMP MUST BE RE-ELECTED**

### **INTRODUCTORY REMARKS**

Donald J(ohn)Trump, the 45<sup>th</sup> President of the United States of America, was born (June 14, 1946) and raised in Queens, a borough of New York City. Trump is a patriotic nationalist, positive populist, anti-New World Order politician, and a protector of free enterprise. A projected reduction of costs is possible for 2020 as the President gives his promise to shield seniors and put patients in charge. In part D of Medicare, beneficiaries choose the prescription drugs that meet their needs and plans to improve quality and achieve cost reductions, thus attracting more beneficiaries.

This dynamic competitive seeks to set manifest incentives that move towards value. Beneficiaries have been allowed to choose other plans with higher negotiating tools developed in the private market, thus providing transparency on drug prices. Strengthening negotiations and increasing competition are the President's main pillars in reducing a lowering of prescription drug prices. The Coalition for Medicare Choices (CMC), founded in 1999, seeks to continue to implement Donald Trump's proposal to ensure that the American people can access prescription drugs at affordable prices. For the first time in a decade, the agency has redesigned the Master Plan Finder website for choosing Medicare plans, making it easier to compare coverage options and find suitable Medicare patient-oriented health and drug plans.

Re-electing Donald Trump as President will ensure that medical costs will be lowered and that there will be more revamping of medical services. A major overhaul will be the rescinding of Barack Hussein Obama's *Affordable (Medical) Care Act*, which was not affordable and had to be passed into law so that Americans could see what was in it. Once American citizens realized what was in the *Affordable Care Act*, they were overwhelmed by the scandal of lies that Barack Hussein Obama, Nancy Pelosi, and the

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, the growth of jobs has leaped from 2.7 million to 5 million. The jobless rate is declining.

Gains in employment and job creation mean that the economy has been adding jobs every month for the past three-plus years of Trump's administration. The unemployment rate that was previously below the norm has drastically been reduced to the lowest since Trump assumed office. His administration's pro-growth agenda gives creators of jobs a framework they need to enlarge their commerce and offer more employment opportunities. The growth of employment combined with continuous income rise is a positive sign for the economy. It has improved the quality of employees' lives and enticed Americans who, under Obama's regime, were left behind with their food stamps. A positive result is that former jobless Americans have joined the labor force.

The unemployment rate fell to 3.5% as of September 2019, making history for the lowest mark since May 1969, which is over 50 years, meaning that nearly all Americans were profiting from the labor market's continuous improvements. In addition, the unemployment rates for people with disabilities and African Americans have recorded the lowest index. People without diplomas the lowest unemployment rates since 1992, and when Donald Trump assumed office, the number fell faster than the number for the unemployed people with degrees. The length of expansion and low unemployment rate, as well as continued growth demonstrates that the labor market is strong. With the re-election of Donald Trump, the unemployment numbers will continue to decline.

### **3. TRUMP'S GOVERNMENT HAS PLACED TARIFFS ON CHINESE PRODUCTS IN RESPONSE TO THE THEFT OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY, TECHNOLOGY TRANSMISSION, AND UNFAIR TRADE PRACTICES.**

For years, China has practiced unfair trade and industrial policies that include the theft of intellectual property (infringement of international copyrights), questionable technology transfer, price dumping, and production overcapacity. These actions made the Chinese firms profitable. Companies in the United States of America could not compete fairly. China imposed higher tariffs on the United States than the United States imposed on China. In 2018, Donald Trump's government announced the decision to protect United States manufacturers from rising imports of Chinese machines and Chinese solar products. These actions retaliate against the harmful trade practices undertaken by China and other countries, including attempts by them to avoid lawful, obligatory countervailing duties and anti-dumping penalties. Trump's administration has added 25% tariffs on products manufactured by China's unfair industrial policies. The Department of Energy has also proposed limitations on investments by China in critical technology. The President also signed a bill that would enable the United States to take active steps in guarding against abusive trade practices and the theft of intellectual property and technology.

A re-election of Donald Trump will ensure that China will be faced with a formidable opponent regarding the theft of intellectual property, unfair trade practices, the flooding of international markets with cheap, inferior quality goods, products, and services that are under par, and uncontrolled, international Chinese expansion.

### **4. Trump's ADMINISTRATION HAS MADE AMERICA A PROFITABLE NATURAL GAS PRODUCER**

From 1957 to date, the United States has increasingly marketed more natural gas with production growth projected to rise even further. As a player in the natural gas markets, the future of America looks bright as production soared to high levels last year. Increased production levels have led the country to reduce its reliance on foreign natural gas imports, as production increased by 43% from 2007 to 2017.

According to energy reports, natural gas has significantly transformed the domestic markets as natural gas producers can offer bundled or unbundled services to customers, thus generating increasing revenue. A bundling of energy enables people to use the convenience of multiple domestic services, such as electricity and gas, which are part of the same energy package. The bundling of benefits can save a homeowner money and make it easier to monitor expenses. Some energy providers refer to it as a dual-fuel plan, an energy package, a bundle, or an energy deal.

The natural gas industry today has developed dramatically. It is more open to competition and choice. There is no longer regulation of wellhead prices, meaning the price of natural gas is dependent on supply and demand interactions. Interstate pipelines no longer take ownership of the natural gas. They offer only the transportation component, which is still under federal regulation. Local distribution companies continue to offer bundled products to their customers, although in many states retail unbundling allows the use of their distribution network for the transportation component exclusively. End-users may purchase natural gas directly from producers or local distribution companies.

This revolution in the natural gas industry has resulted in a rising number of other countries that consume natural gas, from 15 to 39 in 2019.

With a re-election of President Trump, it is expected that American natural gas will attract new customers, especially from third-world countries. There will be increased exports with a very positive economic impact. Under a new Trump administration, the American natural gas industry will create new, specialized jobs.

## **5. Trump's Administration Fights The Opioid Epidemic.**

An opioid is a drug that, when consumed, has similar effects as morphine in the human body. An opioid epidemic is the misuse or overuse of opioid substances with significant medical, social, and economic consequences, including overdose deaths. When the President took office, there was an opioid crisis ravaging communities throughout America. It is estimated that more than 20,000 people died from opioid overdose in 2016 alone. In 2017, President Trump declared the opioid epidemic an

emergency and applied a decisive administration approach by taking the necessary actions to stop the crisis. Some of the actions taken were to reduce demand, to stop over-prescription, and to educate people about the dangers of opioids. His administration also cut the supply of illicit substances by cracking down on opioid supply chains. The number of heroin users has been reduced by more than 50%, and the high costs of prescriptions have fallen to 16%. In 2017, the Food and Drug Administration's Branch of Supply Chain closed down one of the large distributors of counterfeit versions of drugs.

One synthetic opioid, Fentanyl, is 100 times more potent than morphine and 50 times more potent than heroin. The United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) captured more than 2,383 pounds of the substance in 2017. About 2.2 pounds of Fentanyl will yield approximately 1.5 million pill units. Donald Trump's administration has provided outpatient facilities and private specialists to offer treatment to young adults struggling with addiction.

A re-election of Donald Trump will guarantee law enforcement against opioids in five areas: online, finance, international, state, and municipal partnerships. There will be an increased implementation of resources and law enforcement to stop the epidemic from spreading further.

## **6. U. S. MANUFACTURERS ARE CONFIDENT ABOUT THE FUTURE**

The majority of manufacturers in the United States are confident about the growth of their companies in the coming years. Economic optimism regarding business and personal finances have never been higher in the past 44 years. This optimism has been attributed to President Trump's economic growth policies and tax reforms. Manufacturers had promised that when the national tax reforms came into law, they would help their communities and their people. Because the federal tax reforms were passed into law, manufacturers are now planning to keep their promise by hiring a new workforce, improving benefits, buying equipment, and expanding their operations.

With a re-election of President Trump, manufacturing activities are set to rise. Capital investments will increase, and sales will increase by at least 6% in the re-elected Trump administration.

## **RECAPITULATION**

The sections above are only six reasons out of hundreds of why Donald trump must be re-elected as President of the United States of America on November 3, 2020.
