Opening Statement

Mr. Don Fredrick, author and chronologist of *The Obama Timeline* at Colony 14.net, states that Michelle Obama's "address could have been titled, 'It's All About Me,' inasmuch as she used the words **I**, **I've**, **I'd**, **I'll**, **we**, **me**, **my** and **our** 181 times. The graduates may not have received any good advice from (Michelle) Obama, but they certainly learned a lot about *how she feels*." Mr. Fredrick highlights the first-person singular and plural references in green.

There are 179 sentences in Michelle Obama's speech to the University of Northern Iowa's graduating class of 2011. Of these 179 sentences, 91 sentences are Michelle-Obama-self-reference sentences. In the remaining sentences she does not refer to herself. Therefore, dividing the total 181 self-references by 91 self-reference sentences results in a ratio quotient of 1.99 self-references per self-reference sentence. At least with respect to this speech, we have to give Michelle Obama credit. She can compete with her narcissistic husband and putative president Barack Hussein Obama, who also has an extreme egocentric drive to refer to himself in his speeches.

1. "Thank you so much.

COMMENT: Mrs. Thug, also known as Michelle Obama, the wife of Mr. Thug, Barack Hussein Obama, politely bullies the audience into thanking her for being at UNI on this very special day for Mrs. Thug.

2. I am thrilled and honored to be here today to help celebrate the UNI class of 2011 – congratulations to all of you on making it to this day.

COMMENT: Is a thrill going up her like leg like it does with Chris Mathews? Mrs. Thug is honored to be at UNI on this very special day for her. The UNI Class of 2011 made it to this ceremony? They indicate an incorrect, grammatical inflation and exaggeration of a thought. 13. You see, this state, the people I've met here, and the things that I've learned here have all become an important part of my own journey.

COMMENT: Michelle Obama's insecure character is permeating her transparent being!

15. Most folks barely knew who my husband was, let alone who I was.

COMMENT: The majority of American legal citizens truly regret knowing who Mr. and Mrs. Thug are!

16. I was still a bit uneasy about the whole "President thing," as our daughter Malia called it.

COMMENT: The bogus potus has a presidential thing!

17. I didn't know what it would do to our family or how it would affect our girls.

COMMENT: Michelle Obama did not care how it would influence her family and affect her daughters. Michelle Obama was only concerned with being in the limelight with her criminal husband. Michelle Obama should be concerned with what her daughters will think of their criminal parents when the truth is revealed to the public. It will be revealed to the public and hopefully as rapidly as possible. 21. I'll always remember this one gathering in Sioux City, back in the early days.

COMMENT: Back in what early days, the early days of Sioux City? The early days of Sioux City were the decade beginning with its founding in 1854. This makes Mrs. Thug at the most 157 years old.

22. We were all at the home of a lovely family.

COMMENT: If they were a lovely family they would not have had Mr. and Mrs. Thug as guests. One can only surmise that the family regrets their exploited hospitality.

23. It was a beautiful day, so we were all out in the backyard, folks of all ages sitting on lawn chairs and on the grass, and even though not one single person there had ever met me before, I was warmly welcomed like an old friend.

COMMENT: Mr. and Mrs. Thug were holding court with some of their Obots. At the age of 152, Michelle Obama was more than old.

24. So, we just started to talk to one another about our lives and our experience[s], and the more we talked, the more my fears and apprehensions started to fade away.

COMMENT: It is difficult to believe that they talked and that I-centered Mr. Thug and I-centered Mrs. Thug did not monopolize the talking. Was it talking or conversation? Babies talk and say nothing. Grown-ups, specifically Obots and progressives talk and say nothing. When conversations take place intellectual exchanges occur. Evidently, they just talked!

2. The people caused Michelle Obama to recall from memory experiences of her parents, her aunts and uncles, and the kids on the block

27. I just felt at home.

COMMENT: This is difficult to believe. The Iowa and the Iowans that I know and have experienced are not criminals!

28. So at home, in fact, that I kicked off my high-heels and started walking around barefoot in the grass.

COMMENT: That is what progressives do! They kick off! They also kick everyone else who is not of their political opinion.

29. And that's how I wound up feeling just about everywhere I went throughout the state.

COMMENT: There are sixteen definitions of wind (wound) in *The American Heritage Dictionary of the English Language*. None of the definitions state that the use that Michelle Obama applies to wound is acceptable. The use is not even stated. Michelle Obama's use of the word is a very low colloquialism English meaning in this sentence *came to feel*. Nevertheless, Michelle Obama wound up in 2007 and she has not wound down since. In effect, Mrs. and Mr. Thug are ever winding, whether it is lies, scandals, breaking the law, or screwing the American taxpayer. Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

30. Though for the record, I kept my shoes on most of the time.

31. And it wasn't just how folks treated me.

32. It was how they treated my whole family.

COMMENT: Were the family shoes on or off?

33. In Pella, an entire neighborhood sang "Happy Birthday" to Malia on the 4th of July.

COMMENT: The innocent children will be kept out of this truthful commentary.

34. At the State Fair, they poked fun at Barack when he lost a carnival game.

COMMENT: They did not poke fun at Mr. Thug for losing the carnival game. The people at the State Fair poked fun at Barack Hussein Obama for not having the intelligence and adeptness to win the carnival game. Rumors contend that Barack Hussein Obama at that time was not adept at causing documents to be forged claiming that he had won the carnival game.

37. Now, these communities may not have been exactly like the one I grew up in.

COMMENT: How true that is! They are not in any manner connected with Chicago and/or the Chicago Slumlord Valerie Bowman Jarrett.

38. The folks I met may not have come from exactly the same background as me.

COMMENT: They may not? The folks Michelle Obama met did not come from "exactly the same background as" Michelle Obama, because that background was Michelle Obama's background only. They may have come from a similar background, however.

39. But the more that I shared my story with all of you and you shared your stories with me, the more I realized that what truly connects us is our shared values, in the end there is so much more that unites us than divides us.

COMMENT: It should be "what truly connect us are our shared values," Michelle Obama shared her story with all of the persons present at the graduation ceremony and all of the persons present at the graduation ceremony shared their stories with Michelle Obama? This is difficult to believe. Yet, that is what Mrs. Thug says. There is serious doubt that the people at the graduation ceremony share the same values as Mrs. Thug, whose values are the Chicago-Way-and-Pay-to-Play values. Persons interested in Mrs. Thug's values should read Michelle Malkin's *Culture of Corruption* (2009).

40. And that's really what I want to talk with all of you about today – I want to talk about those values.

41. The values you've learned here at UNI.

COMMENT: This author researched the curriculum fields of the University of Northern Iowa and found no subject fields with values as their content. Perhaps values are subordinate subjects of the following areas of study: Art, Design and Music, Business Communications and Media, Computers, Technology & Industry, Education and Training, Health, Medical & Social Service, Human Behavior & Culture, Language & International Studies, Liberal and General Studies, Literature and Writing, Politics and Government, Science and Mathematics, Sports and Recreation. Whatever values might be taught in any of these fields of study, if they are leftist, they are not moral values.

42. The values you've learned growing up and spending time here in Iowa.

COMMENT: Values are desirable principles that a person possesses. The most important values one learns when growing up are honesty, friendliness, courage, morals, promptness, respect for the law, patriotism, and logical judgment. This author would hope that the values one learns in Iowa are the same or similar.

43. And how those values will serve you every step of the way on the journey ahead.

COMMENT: The statement "those values will serve you every step of the way on the journey ahead" has been with civilization since the ages of the ancient Greek and Roman philosophers. Indeed, in the sense that the above characteristics in COMMENT to Number 42 were aspects that enabled Stone Age people to be able to encounter their futures, the statement is even older. Mrs. Thug is so intellectually encompassing! Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

44. The first value I want to discuss is in many ways the most important – but it's also the most often taken for granted – and that is the power of family.

COMMENT: Power of family is not a value! The cohesiveness of the family is a value. Power is something different. It is used to mean strength or force, as well as the exercise of control. Mrs. Thug does not know what she intends to say. Mrs. Thug means the capacity of a family to support each other so that the family has the capacity to be an effective family. Perhaps Mrs. Thug can speak only in terms of power. For

45. Now, this is something that all you folks here in Iowa understand in your bones, to your core.

COMMENT: Mrs. Thug! Bones cannot understand values. They can only understand communicated body messages via electrical/muscular impulses. What is the core of an individual? Philosophically speaking it is the soul. However, what happens when a person does not have a soul, or better, has a corrupted soul? Can a corrupted soul understand something other than corruption? Perhaps with such experience Mrs. Thug can answer these questions.

46. I saw it everywhere I went – strong, connected families that looked out for each other and supported each other through good times and bad.

COMMENT: Mrs. Thug is taking a special theme of her husband Mr. Thug and insinuating the communal relationship of communism!

47. And I can tell you from my own experience that nothing else in your life – nothing, not your job, not your hobbies, not the money in your bank account – nothing will sustain you like family.

COMMENT: Mrs. and Mr. Thug think and politicize quite differently, for this statement contradicts the teachings of socialism/communism, which say that the party and the state are responsible for the person from the cradle to the grave. Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

48. When I was growing up, we might not have had much, but my family was – and still is – my rock.

COMMENT: There is an incongruity of thought in the statement. To which family is Michelle Obama referring? The family Michelle Obama had when she was growing up is not the family she now has. The statement of the sentence is that her family, the Robinson family was her *rock* when she was growing up and now her family, the Robinson family is still her *rock*. Does Michelle Obama's own family have no meaning for Michelle Obama? Michelle Obama uses *rock* in a metaphorical sense like suggesting a source of strength.

49. I was raised in modest means, probably like many of you.

COMMENT: This statement is an imposition. Michelle Obama is making an unfounded assumption. There is no logic to the statement.

50. We lived on the top floor of a two-family home on the South Side of Chicago.

COMMENT: The South Side of Chicago is not Euclid Street where Mrs. Thug grew up. The real name of the Chicago City district is South Shore. Michelle Obama should know that. The South Side of Chicago is a geographical reference that includes all of the regions south of the Chicago River except the Chicago Loop, the historic commercial center of downtown Chicago. The South Side covers 60% of the Chicago land area.

51. My dad worked in the boiler room at the city water plant.

COMMENT: Michelle Obama's father, Fraser C. Robinson III, was a pump worker in the water works of the City of Chicago. He had the responsible, political pay-off work of overseeing the boilers of the city's water treatment plant. Well, Michelle Obama, let's tell the true story! "Mrs. Obama was literally born into the Chicago political corruptocracy. Her father, Fraser Robinson, was a volunteer precinct captain for the Democrat Party. *Washington Post* writer Liza Mundy called him 'an essential member of the powerful political machine run by [Richard J.] Daley, who, in addition to being mayor, was the chairman of the Cook County Democratic National committee, meaning he controlled both the government and the political party, and could use one to do the other's bidding.' COMMENT: Mrs. Robinson was a secretary for Spiegel Catalog and a bank. These are not positions to be ashamed of and Michelle Obama should have been more exact.

53. In our household, we had rules, we did our chores, we minded our Q's and we ate our peas.

COMMENT: Michelle Obama is attempting to be comical as well as indicating that the family ate peas, a vegetable for the poor. Michelle Obama means Ps and Qs, which means *to be attentive at what one is doing* or to say *Please and Thank You*.

54. And while we had our share of struggle and heartache, we sure did laugh a lot.

COMMENT: Having a laugh is very good. The tragedy is that now Mrs. and Mr. Thug have become the laughing stock of American constitutionalists, patriots, and the world's major powers. Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

55. And **we** loved each other more than **I** could ever put in words.

COMMENT: The only love that can be put in words is the word *love* itself. Michelle Obama means that she cannot find words to describe it. Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

56. And even though those moments might seem far away, even though **my** father has passed and **my** brother lives 3,000 miles away, the bonds that **we** formed in that tiny apartment still connect us.

COMMENT: This is a very wonderful experience. Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

57. They are – and will always be – **my** core and **my** compass in life.

COMMENT: The unified side of life is one's core, one's being. Life's compass consists of God, family, friends one can really count on, knowledge, morals, honesty, and patriotism. Mrs. Thug may believe that she possesses these. However, it would be positive if Michelle Obama would show honesty, morals, and patriotism.

58. So, graduates, after this ceremony is over, **I** want you to hug those folks up in the stands just a little harder.

COMMENT: The few thousand people who are attending are to hug each other because it is Mrs. Thug's will! If the graduates learned anything at UNI, it should be how to show thanks to loved ones without being told to do so.

59. And then make sure that you call them next week.

COMMENT: Yes, graduates! Call them next week and tell them you need more money to finish off the remaining university graduation parties. Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

60. And the week after that, and the one after that.

COMMENT: This author doubts that the graduates need to be told what to do! Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

61. Because these are the folks who made you who you are.

COMMENT: The graduates made themselves into what they now are.

62. These are the folks who will stand by you no matter what life throws your way.

COMMENT: Will Michelle Obama's family stand by her when the truth about Mr. and Mrs. Thug's criminal and political activity is finally made public?

63. These are the folks who prepared you to succeed here at UNI and who prepared you to contribute to your communities and to your country.

COMMENT: All is well when there are willingness to succeed and contributions to communities that have a moral, legal foundation, as well as respect for political opponents, and for the laws of the country. Mr. and Mrs. Thug do not have these characteristics.

64. And that leads **me** to the second value **I** want to discuss – another thread which is woven throughout this university and this state – and that is the value of service to others.

65. Now, the truth is, many of you could give this part of **my** speech yourselves because you've been living this value every day of your lives.

COMMENT: If some of the graduates were to have given the speech, it would probably have been truthful and not hypocritical.

66. During the floods of 2008, so many of you were out there sandbagging.

COMMENT: Where were Mrs. and Mr. Thug? They were pulling off a coup d'état of the most villainous and treasonous kind.

67. After the tornado, you went over to Parkersburg to provide all kinds of relief services to the victims there.

COMMENT: This was a wonderful action. It out-does Mr. Thug's inaction regarding the Texas call for assistance to combat the raging Texas wilderness fires, which were

intentionally ignited by illegal Mexican aliens, the criminals that Mr. Thug wants to protect.

68. There were the Volunteer Tuesdays, where many of you served at agencies like the Salvation Army and the Northeast Iowa Food Bank.

COMMENT: At least they volunteered. According to this author's knowledge, Mrs. Thug never volunteered for anything, except to take the taxpayers' money for personal vacations, trips, and do-nothing positions.

69. And students here have stepped up to serve our country and wear its uniform at a time when we're asking so much of our troops and their families.

COMMENT: This is true, but Mrs. and Mr. Thug are also requiring them to follow orders that are illegal because both thugs have usurped power positions, one as bogus potus and the other as bogus firstladyus. Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

70. That includes four members of your class who were commissioned as Second Lieutenants in the US Army just this morning.

COMMENT: These newly commissioned Second Lieutenants in the United States Army had better not question and challenge the constitutional eligibility of Mr. Thug, because if they do they will undergo court martial, lose their officers' commissions, and spend time in Leavenworth Army Disciplinary Barracks. At the same time, if they do not question and challenge the eligibility of Mr. Thug, they will be breaking their oaths to uphold the *Constitution for the United States of America*.

71. And I am proud that so many of you have stepped up to support them.

COMMENT: The graduates, the complete University of Northern Iowa, the whole state of Iowa should stand up and support LTC Terrence Lakin, who has the courage to question Mr. Thug's constitutionality. Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

72. You've already launched a veterans student organization.

COMMENT: That is good. However, a veterans' (There should be an 's on veterans if singular is meant and an s' on veterans if plural is meant.) student organization must have veterans. Mr. Thug's rules of engagement that favor the enemy al-Qaeda and the Taliban in Afghanistan will result in fewer veterans.

73. You're putting together a website to connect military students to UNI resources.

COMMENT: If the military students are not allowed by Mr. Thug and his Organizing for America to make any connections to UNI, they will not connect.

74. You're working with the VA to provide matching funds to help vets cover tuition and fees if they need it.

COMMENT: Veterans may need it if Mr. Thug cuts the VA benefits to the dangerous degree that he wants to cut them.

75. And I encourage all of you, no matter where you go in life, keep doing that – keep honoring our troops and their families.

COMMENT: Honor them with pride and patriotism, not with hate and disposal like calling them racists like Mr. and Mrs. Thug do. Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

76. We've all seen, just in the last week, how much these folks deserve our support.

COMMENT: Military personnel are not folk! They are honored American citizens.

77. Just imagine, a small group of brave men, dropped by helicopter, half a world away in the dead of night ... into unknown danger inside the lair of the most sought after man in the world.

COMMENT: If Mr. Thug has his narcissistic way, he will spew out so many United States secrets regarding the kill-bin Laden operation that the Navy SEALs and their families will not be safe from terrorists. If leaking the nomenclature of the SEALs' units, their names, locations, and places that they visit to the lamestream media will assist in Mr. Thug being elected in 2012, Mr. Thug, and indeed, Mrs. Thug will not think twice about the security of these families.

78. They did not hesitate, risking everything for us, for our freedom and security.

COMMENT: That is a formidable risk for patriots who receive the Thug's destruction of America in exchange.

79. And they did it not just as Navy SEALs.

COMMENT: That is their profession and they execute what they are trained to do. Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

80. They did it as husbands, as fathers, as sons.

COMMENT: No!!! They did it as American patriots!!!

81. Their families were back here, with no idea of their mission or whether their loved one would ever come home.

COMMENT: That situation is a pre-understood situation for anyone who is connected with active duty military.

82. That is the very essence of the word "service."

COMMENT: No!!! It is the very essence of patriotism!!! The real essence of Mr. Thug's service is here:

83. And the least we can do is give something back to these troops and their families who have given us so much.

COMMENT: Mr. and Mrs. Thug can start by honoring the *Constitution for the United States of America* and obeying it. Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

84. I have seen again and again that giving back, that serving others, keeps everything in perspective.

COMMENT: Michelle Obama may have seen this, but she has never practiced serving others, at least not voluntarily.

85. Service is what connects us to one another, to our neighbors, our communities, our country, it reminds us that we are not simply individuals living isolated lives, but that we're all woven together.

COMMENT: We Americans are absolutely not woven together by this socialism/communism slop, but by a belief in God, by the love of country, by the will to be free and remain free, and by the will not be exploited by Obamatrons and progressives.

86. So graduates, I hope that you all keep finding new ways that you can make that kind of impact.

COMMENT: Michelle Obama! Leave them alone and without Obama brainwashing! They will find ways to make a moral, patriotic impact in life.

87. In **my** own life, **I've** found that helping military families is just one way that resonates with **me**.

COMMENT: There is nothing tangibly lasting that Mrs. Thug has done to help military families, but she surely can talk about it.

88. It's one of **my** passions, and it has driven **me** to start a nationwide effort called Joining Forces to honor these military families.

COMMENT: This is an interesting statement. It contradicts Mr. Thug's rules of engagement that place active military members in danger and is a threat to their families.

89. This passion keeps **me** going every day, knowing that **I'm** part of something so much bigger, so much more important than just **my** own individual wants and needs.

COMMENT: There is a confession of truth in this statement. It is that Michelle Obama has her own individual wants and needs!

90. And that's the third value **I** hope that you will all embrace – to find that passion within yourself, and follow it wherever it takes you.

COMMENT: Passion is okay. Exercising logic and keeping one's feet on the ground and not losing touch with reality is better. Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

91. With all of the classes, extracurricular activities, and other experiences you've had over the last four years, this university has given you so many chances to discover that passion.

COMMENT: Discover which passion? A university provides its students the opportunity to receive an education so that they can encounter their post-academic life successfully. The university system does not educate passion.

92. But that process of discovery doesn't stop when you leave this campus. **I** know that from **my** own experience.

COMMENT: Mrs. Thug never experienced a process of discovery. She never experienced real work. Michelle Obama's real passion was hating America and being friends with terrorists like William Ayers and Bernadine Dhorn.

93. Back when I graduated from college, I was certain that I wanted to be a lawyer.

COMMENT: Did Michelle Obama attend college or university? She attended Yale University and then Harvard University. Does Michelle Obama not know the difference between a college and a university? Well you can tell a Harvard graduate, but you cannot tell this Harvard graduate much!

94. So I did everything I was supposed to do. I got my law degree.

COMMENT: The law degree is a Juris Doctor from Harvard University in 1988. Why is she not proud enough to say such? It is interesting to note that Barack Hussein Obama, Mr. Thug, received a Juris Doctor from Harvard University in 1991, but no one has seen the document! The motto of Harvard University is VERITAS. Mrs. and Mr. Thug apparently do not know this, and if they do, they do not care, since both are adept in *dolus malus* (unlawful deceit)!

95. I went home and got a job at a big firm in Chicago.

COMMENT: Mrs. Thug lost her law license (court ordered) in 1993 due to some criminal action when she was working for Mayor Daley of Chicago.

96. By all appearances, I was living the dream.

COMMENT: This is a logical statement. A dream is a kind of appearance!

97. But the truth is, all the while that I was climbing, I knew something was missing.

COMMENT: What was missing is the fact that Mrs. Thug was not earning enough money for doing nothing.

98. Sure, I was working up in a tall building downtown, but when I looked out across the skyline of the city, even though I could see the community I'd come from off in the distance, I was so far up, and so far away, I couldn't feel that community.

COMMENT: No one forced Michelle Obama to work there.

99. I felt like I was beginning to lose that connection to where I had come from.

COMMENT: She was losing the connection because she was not keeping her feet on the ground and she was having a rejection of her rising expectations.

100. And I realized that I didn't want to climb anymore.

COMMENT: No! Michelle Obama realized that she couldn't because she was incompetent in climbing the successful social-economic ladder on her own. It meant that she would have had to work! Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

101. I wanted to be grounded, working with the folks that I knew, folks like the ones I grew up with.

COMMENT: Michelle Obama is so folksy! Folksy means simple and unpretentious in social behavior. Is this the real Michelle Obama: unpretentious and simple? The references to herself in this speech are ample proof of Michelle Obama's simplicity and unpretentiousness!

102. I wanted to be mentoring young people, I wanted to be helping families put food on the table and a roof over their heads, I wanted to be giving folks the kind of chances that I'd had.

COMMENT: Mrs. Thug is so good at helping others on the surface which results in achieving her goal of advancing and helping herself instead of others.

103. So I did something that shocked my friends and family, and added about a decade onto my student loan debt: I quit that job.

COMMENT: Complaining about student loans is one of Michelle Obama's standard quips. Mrs. and Mr. Thug's stance on student loans is: We borrowed money from the taxpayers to obtain degrees, honestly or dishonestly, from ivy league universities. We have taken our time paying them back (If that is what really happened.), because we do what we feel like doing. Owing the taxpayers money sucks!

104. I left that high-paying firm to go work for the city government.

COMMENT: Of the lies in this speech, this one is the most blatant. She did not quit that good-paying job. She was recruited to work for Mayor Richard Daley by the criminal Valerie *Slumlord* Jarrett. Michelle Obama took the new position only after guarantees that she would be looked after and adequately paid. (Michelle Malkin, *Culture of Corruption*, p. 50.)

105. And from there, I moved on to lead a nonprofit organization called Public Allies, helping young people pursue public service careers.

COMMENT: Public Allies is a (criminal) organization that is taxpayer-funded protesters' money. It is a socialist/communist scam with the intention of destroying America's capitalist and republican principles. Public Allies was founded by Vanessa Kirsch and Katrina Browne in Washington, D. C. in 1992 and by Barack Hussein Obama in Chicago in 1992. Michelle Obama became its executive director. The organization uses taxpayer money to pay people to sign up as members. The members' job is to protest. Their creed is that America is a racist, oppressive nation in need of social change into socialism/communism. Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

106. I wasn't making nearly as much money and my office wasn't nearly as big or as nice, but I was working with terrific young people and colleagues who inspired me.

COMMENT: Mrs. Thug was using taxpayer money to achieve socialism/communism.

107. I found that I would wake up every day with excitement, with a sense of purpose and possibility, because I was finally doing something that made me feel fully alive.

COMMENT: Michelle Obama could tell young people what to do and could collect a large sum of money as payment.

108. And graduates, that's what I wish for all of you today – for you to find that career, that calling, that makes you feel alive.

COMMENT: Okay graduates, establish a taxpayer-funded-destroy-America scheme and have your calling. Have fun at the expense of the hard-working taxpayer! Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

109. Now, I know that your passions may not be the same as mine.

COMMENT: Most of the people have legal and personal passions and not questionable socialist/communist, political passions.

110. You may feel most alive in front of a classroom, or a board room, or even in one of those high-rise Chicago office buildings.

COMMENT: Are there degrees of feeling alive? Here they are à la Michelle Obama: alive, more alive, most alive, or better yet, so alive, so much more alive, so much most

alive, or better yet, really so much alive, really so much more alive, really so much most alive.

111. But no matter what it is, keep that fire burning.

COMMENT: Keep the fire burning, or you will freeze in Iowa and in Chicago in the winter! The Thugs turn the thermostat in the White House up to 80° F in the winter!

112. I know that it won't always be easy.

COMMENT: What intelligence! Life is not easy! *Man muss das Leben eben nehmen wie das Leben eben ist!* (One must just accept this life simply as it is!) Perhaps one should become a socialist/communist. Then life is easy. The government and the party will do everything for you, pay everything for you, and you can become like Mrs. and Mr. Thug, parasites that live off of the hard-working taxpayers. In the United States of America the Thugs and the unions have brought about the situation where there are now more legal and illegal parasites than there are legal producers. (<http://www.thefiscaltimes.com/Columns/2011/04/18/Budget-Deficit-Government-Handouts-Top-Tax-Income.aspx>)

113. The path won't always be laid out neatly for you.

COMMENT: Another intelligent quip!

114. Sometimes you won't be able to find that perfect job.

COMMENT: Nobody is perfect and no profession is perfect, unless you have a position subsidized by a taxpayer-funded scam. Then the job is exploitation of the taxpayer. However, if the person occupies such a socialist/communist/democrat-founded position, that person will not complain about the parasitic exploitation.

115. Sometimes you might momentarily take a job just to stay afloat.

COMMENT: Are UNI graduates boats or ships?

116. Those are the realities of life.

COMMENT: What intelligence! Life has realities! Oh my, life is a reality!

117. But no matter what you do from nine to five, know that you should always try to find some way to pursue what you love.

COMMENT: This is the problem with the United States of America. It is union-regulated work 9-5! People should pursue whom they love and undertake a profession they prefer.

118. Maybe it's a hobby that one day becomes your own business.

COMMENT: Once the hobby becomes your business, Mr. Thug or some other Democrat Party socialist/communist will make sure that it is taxed at the highest rate.

119. Maybe it's some volunteer work that helps you develop new skills and passions.

COMMENT: Volunteer work can develop new skills, but volunteer work never develops passion. Passion is developed by a sustained or a passing of a strong feeling that is deeply emotional. When misused in the sense that Michelle Obama thinks is the correct usage, passion implies nothing more than an avid interest. Mrs. Thug, a Yale University graduate and a Harvard University graduate should know these differences. Evidently, Michelle Obama is not and never was aware of the meaning of some words that she uses falsely. A better word is *enthusiasm*.

120. You will have some false starts and setbacks along the way.

COMMENT: This is another Michelle Obama intelligent quip! What succinct knowledge is contained in this sentence! The author wishes that he had said this!!!

121. But I promise you that if you keep listening to yourself, and keep yourself open to new possibilities, new people, and new ways of thinking, you will find a place in this world that feels right for you.

COMMENT: Mrs. Thug should not make promises that she cannot keep. However, she is being consistent with Mr. Thug, who makes promises only to get elected to office, but hopefully will never keep them, which in the long run will be extremely positive for the United States of America. Should the UNI graduates find a place in this world or in this America?

122. And that openness – that willingness to be exposed to new people and experiences – that is the final value I want to discuss today.

COMMENT: The "willingness to be exposed to new people and experiences" is not a value. It is a nose experience only. Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

123. This is something that I think truly defines the state of Iowa and its people.

COMMENT: Nosey experiences define the state of Iowa? How dumb and stupid!

124. You all don't rush to judgment.

COMMENT: Yes, do not do as Mrs. and Mr. Thug do when they call *racist!*"

125. You'll give just about anyone a respectful hearing.

COMMENT: Just like Mr. Thug and his military cronies did with LTC Terrence Lakin who underwent court martial because he challenged Mr. Thug's constitutional qualifications to be president. LTC Lakin was denied the right to defend himself in a military court. The military judge reasoned that LTC Lakin could not exercise his constitutional right to defend himself because it might embarrass Mr. Thug.

126. That was certainly **my** experience.

COMMENT: This author can only accept this statement as an outright lie. Mrs. Thug does not know what respect is!

127. People didn't know a thing about **me**, yet they listened, they asked questions, they gave **me** the benefit of the doubt and a chance to show who **I** was.

COMMENT: What Mr. Thug has turned out to become was way beyond the imagination of those people who gave Michelle Obama the benefit of the doubt and a chance to show who she was. The majority of Americans regret their decision because Michelle Obama is an accomplice in Mr. Thug's usurpation of power.

128. And that's because people here in Iowa understand that everyone has something to offer.

COMMENT: This is true. Everyone does have something to offer. However, Mrs. Thug was always on the taking side, like being awarded (sometimes by Mr. Thug as a US Senator) with receive-a-lot-of-money-for-doing-nothing positions on a variety of "community and corporate boards that pumped her income up to \$500,000 in 2007". (Michelle Malkin, *Culture of Corruption* ,p 66.) Corruption is because the corrupt do! Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

129. Just think about your classmates here at UNI.

COMMENT: Are the UNI graduates passionate about each other?

130. While you all might look similar in your black robes today, I know there is a kaleidoscope of talents, passions and experiences with which you've enriched each other these past four years.

COMMENT: Wow! All of the graduates are richer than they were four years ago because of each other! This author remembers his university education – it was not a college – and the fact that he was *richer* after four years of attending university was due to the excellent non-leftist educators – not teachers – and the fact that he studied.

131. We've got graduates like Darion Watson, from Gary, Indiana.

COMMENT: Okay.

132. He's the first person in his family to go to college – and he's inspired his older siblings to think about getting their degrees, too.

COMMENT: Okay, but big deal! This author was the first in his family to go to university! That fact does not make the author special. Mrs. Thug should have explained why Darion Watson of Gary, Indiana is important and is to be respected. Darion Watson is the first UNI student to receive recognition as the State of Iowa Student Employee of the Year by the Midwest Association of Student Employment Association. Perhaps Michelle Obama thought that she would be upstaged if she explained Darion Watson's accomplishment! Mrs. and Mr. Thug resent being upstaged!

133. We've got graduates like Ashleigh Peska from Martelle, Iowa, who works tirelessly across the state to raise awareness for people with muscular dystrophy.

COMMENT: It is very accomplishing that "Ashleigh Peska from Martelle, Iowa works tirelessly across the state to raise awareness for people with muscular dystrophy". Yet being mentioned at the UNI graduation by a person who never really worked in her life, to not even mention having worked tirelessly, is like a microbe bacteria paying an elephant a compliment.

134. We've got graduates like Renee Rapier, a singer from Marion, Iowa, who has won opera awards all across this country, even being invited by one of the Three Tenors to sing out in Los Angeles.

COMMENT: Michelle Obama! Renee Rapier is not just "a singer"! Renee Rapier is a mezzo soprano. Give Renee Rapier the respect that she deserves. Singers are singers and mezzo sopranos are more than "singers"! Therefore, they are very special. Excellent mezzo sopranos like Renee Rapier can be counted on one hand!

135. And we've got graduates like Nadine Ishimwe, who survived the Rwandan genocide as a child and came to Cedar Falls four years ago when she couldn't even read, write, or speak English.

COMMENT: Michelle Obama! Give credit where credit is due. It is the organization of Cedar Heights Community Presbyterian Church that brought Nadine Ishimwe and her sister Diane to the United States and provided them with financial support. Financial aid was invested in their futures. The financial support that Michelle Obama received as an attendee at university was taxpayer-supported. As a so-called professional in Chicago it was taxpayer-funded scam money. Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

136. Each of these students – and every single one of you – is unique in some way.

COMMENT: What an astounding statement! Every student is unique because each one is a student. All people, whether student or not, are unique in some way.

137. Each of you has something different to teach the rest of us.

COMMENT: Everybody has this capability. They should polish their capabilities in the free market economy system and not in socialism/communism, where the party and the government will exploit them.

138. And I would urge you to be curious about those who have experiences different from yours.

COMMENT: There is nothing intellectual in this statement. It is done every day. Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

139. Learn from them.

COMMENT: Above all, learn the moral aspects.

140. Let their ideas and experiences challenge your own assumptions and perspectives.

COMMENT: It might be more productive for the UNI graduates to let their assumptions and perspectives challenge the ideas and experiences of others.

141. But at the end of the day, don't ever lose sight of what makes you unique.

COMMENT: At the end of the day it is time to go to bed. What Michelle Obama means is that in the short term and the long term one should be true to the morals within one's character. However, this statement coming from Mrs. Thug is like taking a lesson from the devil's servant.

142. Don't ever stop believing in what you have to offer.

COMMENT: As long as one's beliefs are based on moral, legal principles, the person will be successful. Mrs. and Mr. Thug have achieved their status based on criminal actions. History is already their judge and that judgment is not good for the naïve electorate in the United States of America and it is not good for the relationships that the United States of America have with the other nations in the world.

143. Don't ever count yourself out.

COMMENT: But do not do as Mrs. and Mr. Thug and place your non-character in the hands of anti-Americans and terrorists.

144. And if you ever do begin to doubt yourself, if you ever start to wonder whether you can fulfill all those dreams.

COMMENT: It is difficult to comment regarding the above because it is not a sentence. There is no closure! Michelle Obama must have missed a lecture in English and logic at Yale University and Harvard University, or is it college? Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

145. I want you to think of two words that showed this country that young people here at UNI have got what it takes.

COMMENT: What are those two words? Be honest?

146. Those words?

COMMENT: Okay, this author is ready for these TWO WORDS!

147. "Ali Farokhmanesh."

COMMENT: This is a name. Ali Farokhmanesh is a basketball player. He plays professional basket ball in Massagno, Switzerland. *Ali* is Arabic and means *Exalted One*. *Farokhmanesch* is a compound name of *Farok(h)* and *Manesch*. *Farok(h)* is Arabic and means *discerning truth from falsehood*. *Manesh* is Hindu and means *lord of*

opinion. Now these are words that show character quality. Perhaps that is the reason Michelle Obama did not mention their meanings. Mrs. Thug like Mr. Thug would surely have a difficulty with exalted, discerning truth from falsehood and lord of opinion.

148. And then I want you to think about all those other men and women who have come before you, the long list of distinguished alumni who have sat where you're sitting today.

COMMENT: You will do as I say. The UNI Dome was built in 1976. Are the previous distinguished alumni who were not able to be seated in the Dome before 1976 excluded? Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

149. There's molly Boyle, Iowa's Teacher of the Year.

COMMENT: This is not to belittle Molly Boyle. Nevertheless, this author asks: Is Molly Boyle a teacher or an educator? Verily there is a great difference. (<http://www.colony14.net/sitebuildercontent/sitebuilderfiles/education.pdf>)

150. Chuck Grassley, a six-term U.S. Senator.

COMMENT: Mrs. Thug really goes beyond her standards and mentions a Senator from the Republican Party, the political party that Mr. Thug would like to exterminate forever.

151. The first African-American principal in Iowa, Walter Cunningham.

COMMENT: It is not where one is from. It is whether or not one is successful. Apparently Walter Cunningham is successful.

152. Nancy Powell, the Director-General of the United States Foreign Service.

COMMENT: Is that all that Nancy Jo Powell has as a claim to fame? She graduated from UNI in 1970 and entered the United States diplomatic service in 1977. She has served in at least the following positions: Ambassador to Nepal, Ambassador to Pakistan, Ambassador to Ghana, Ambassador to Uganda, Deputy Chief of Mission at the U.S. Embassy in Dhaka, Bangladesh, Political Counselor at the U.S. Embassy in New Delhi, India, Consul General in Calcutta, India, Deputy Chief of Mission in Lome, Togo.

153. And then there's Nancy Aossey.

COMMENT: Okay. The following information regarding Nancy Aossey is from (<http://www.internationalmedicalcorps.org/Document.Doc?id=76>). It is factual and non-colloquialism. Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

154. Nancy grew up in Cedar Rapids, dreaming of faraway countries and peoples.

COMMENT: Young people always have dreams of far away countries and peoples. This is nothing about which one is to become flabbergast red.

155. She got her B.A. and her MBA at UNI in the early '80s, and then took a job selling phones.

COMMENT: Being in the position that she is, Mrs. Thug should know facts. Nancy Aossey received her Bachelor of Arts degree in Marketing in 1982 and a Masters in Business Administration in 1984. Nancy Aossey did not sell phones, Michelle Obama! Nancy Aossey sold telephone networks to small businesses for AT&T Information Systems.

156. She went out to California, where she heard about a small startup nonprofit called International Medical Corps, an organization that worked in those faraway lands, responding to emergencies and helping local residents become self-reliant.

COMMENT: Get the facts straight Michelle Obama! Nancy Aossey moved to Fresno, California in 1985 because there was a parallel job at AT&T in Fresno.

157. She asked if they needed a volunteer, and it turned out they needed a CEO.

COMMENT: They made an excellent choice, much better than a Michelle Obama, which would have bankrupted them.

158. So Nancy listened to her heart.

COMMENT: Nancy Aossey did not listen to her heart. She listened to her logic as it concerned assisting needy people, regardless of who they were/are.

159. She took over, and IMC took off.

COMMENT: IMC did not take off. IMC grew yearly at an ever faster rate than the year before.

160. All told, they've directed more than a billion dollars in assistance and training worldwide.

COMMENT: The phrase *all told* is completely wrong. It should be *all totaled*!

161. They've touched millions of lives, from Somalia, to the Balkans, to Haiti and Japan.

COMMENT: Who or what is meant with **they**: the people of IMC, the services of IMC, the billion dollars from IMC, or all of them together? Were their lives touched or were their lives secured and saved?

162. And as CEO, Nancy has earned awards that put her in the company of Presidents, Generals, Nobel Prize recipients, and Oscar winners.

COMMENT: Praise be to Nancy Aossey! Never begin a sentence with And. It is childish!

163. Now you might hear Nancy's story and think, "That's pretty cool...but I could never do something like that."

COMMENT: Nancy Aossey's biography and success is not colloquialism *cool*! It is a biography and success that should be emulated. A person can do anything that the person wants, as long as it is legal. Success is always in degrees!

164. But if there's one thing I want to leave you with, it's this: this university and this state have given you everything you need to do something exactly like that.

COMMENT: The University of Northern Iowa and the State of Iowa did not give the graduates everything. They gave the graduates only the exceptional opportunity to be successful in their post-university professions.

165. The values you've learned here—commitment to family, openness to diversity, willingness to serve your community and your country, the courage to follow your passion—those are the keys to success in any field.

COMMENT: See COMMENT at Number 42. If these are values, and this author seriously doubts that they are values, for they are really needs and goals to be followed, then it is interesting that Michelle Obama is telling the graduates to use these keys to unlock their futures, whereas Michelle Obama in her pay-to-play-and-play-to-pay-

Chicago-way lifestyle did not use these as keys to unlock her future. Michelle Obama's keys were taxpayer-funded scams.

166. They are the building blocks of a fulfilling life.
