To The Nobel Peace Prize Committee:

I have argued for months that Obama would be out of the running for the Nobel Peace Prize he so much covets as soon as Israel strikes Iran's nuclear facilities. In fact, Obama's actions are forcing Israel into such a move, as he continues to appease Iran while demanding unreasonable and unjustifiable concessions from Israel that would result in the Jewish state's eventual demise.
