Saving Ryan's Privates

At Lew Rockwell.com Pat Buchanan quotes University of Oxford professor Benjamin Jowett (1817-1893): "Never retreat. Never explain. Get it done and let them howl." Donald Trump, writes Buchanan, "has internalized [that] maxim. ... And in rejecting demands that he apologize for his remarks about the La Raza judge presiding over the class-action suit against Trump University, the Donald is instinctively correct. Assume, as we must, that Trump believes what he said. Why, then, should he apologize for speaking the truth, as he sees it?"

"...When the British were serenely confident in the superiority of their tribe, faith, culture, and civilization, they went out and conquered and ruled and remade the world, and for the better. Three cheers for Mr. Buchanan for pointing out what should be obvious to everyone but which has been hidden for decades under the covers of political correctness and "civilization guilt." No, the Brits should not be ashamed of having had an Empire.
