THE NASTY, FEMALE FASCIST

BACKGROUND

On 19 October 2016, in the third debate leading up to the presidential election in the United States of America on November 8, 2016, the Republican Party candidate Donald A. Trump said directly to the Democratic Party candidate Hillary Rodham Clinton: *You sure are a nasty woman!* The truth behind this statement is that Hillary Clinton is a nasty female fascist! Therefore, a documented, truthful connection of the descriptions **nasty** and **fascist** with the person Hillary Clinton with is herewith undertaken.

ETYMOLOGICAL AND DEFINITION FOUNDATION

NASTY The word **nasty** has its origin in the Indo-Germanic word stem **nizdo**, meaning *bird's nest*. It is a compound root formed with **ni-** meaning *down*, and ***sd-** or ***zd**, the zero-grade forms of **sed-**¹, meaning *to sit*. Thus, we have the complete meaning *the place where the bird sits down*. Consequently, we find in Germanic the term **nist-*. In Old English *nest*. In Germanic there is the verb form **nistilōn* and in Old English there is the verb form *nestilan*, both meaning *to make a nest*. The Indo-European word stem appears in Latin as *nīdus*, meaning *nest*.¹

The Middle English words *nasty* and *naxty* are adjectives. Etymological history is uncertain of their exact developments. However, there are indications bordering on one-hundred percent surety that the Dutch word *nestig*, meaning *dirty*, *unclean*, *foul*, *filthy like a bird's nest* comes from the Indo-Germanic stem **nizdo-** that relates to the Middle English *nasty* and *naxty*.

It appears that the Dutch took the German word **Nest** and added the German suffix **-ig** to it to make the adjective *nestig*. The German adjective suffix ending **-ig** is a very old and often-used ending to make either adjectives or adverbs out of substantives and predicates in which the suffix often uses the same word stem of a basic word that sometimes is more complex and is most likely indicated by the old age of the relevant formations. Nevertheless, the suffix is still productive. Often there is another suffix added to the **-ig** suffix to produce other words in German. An example is *lustig* with *-keit* becomes *Lustigkeit*. (merry becomes merriness). This etymological process is reinforced by a Scandinavian term, the Swedish dialect word *naskug*, meaning *dirty*, *nasty*, made up of nask (Germanic *Nest*) and the **-ug** ending (Germanic **-ig** ending.) Nevertheless, some etymologists argue that *nasty* comes from the Old French *nastre*, meaning *strange*, *lowly*, *bad*, which was separated from the Old French *villenastre*, meaning *infamous*, *ignoble*."²



Of the 63 definitions of **nasty** from the *Urban Dictionary*, the following 12 definitely apply to Hillary Clinton:⁴

FASCIST The word **fascist** comes from the term **fascism**, which has as its source the Indo-Germanic stem **bhasko-**, originally meaning *band* or *bundle*. In Latin, it occurs in *fascis*, meaning *a bundle of rods or twigs or straw*, as well as *a crowd of people*.⁵

This kind of **fasces** was the Etruscan/Roman symbol of the government's power. When consuls (the highest elected officials in the Roman Republic), proconsuls (provincial governors and military commanders), praetors (commanders of an army or an elected magistrate), dictators (rulers of the empire), curule aediles (controllers of public buildings and overseers of law and order), quaestors (government officials whose offices were similar to present-day cabinet members) and the Flamin Dialis (high priest of Jupiter) made public appearances, most often after military victories (Roman triumphs), they were preceded by lictors (civil servant bodyguards) who

carried fasces: bundled birch branches, signifying birching (beatings or whippings) and the protruding axe blade, symbolical of judgement and execution, i.e., the power over life and death.

The fasces have appeared on United States coins and seals. The statue of Abraham Lincoln sits in a chair with fasces armrests in the Lincoln Memorial. The fasces are also on the wall in Congress behind the Speaker of the House's desk and the speaker's lectern.⁶

The *Urban Dictionary* has 30 definitions for **fascist**, of which the following selected 11 describe the person who is Hillary Clinton:⁸



- 4. A person or political party with extreme ... views, often including racism, ... and complete obedience to authority.
- 5. A supporter of a form of government characterized by the merging of business leadership and the state, rigid one-party rule by the extreme ... emphasizing strong centralized power, with militarism, an aggressive nationalism, and the suppression of all opposition.
- 6. A supporter of an extreme ... political belief system and/or government.
- 7. An image of Hillary Clinton that shows her being as a true, nasty fascist without makeup and the accompanying smile that is used to cover up her meanness is the following:





PROOF THAT LEFTISM IS FASCISM AND FASCISM IS LEFTISM

It is extremely important to understand the fool-proof logic that underlies the truth that a fascist is a leftist. I have often stated that

"Being extreme right is the same as being fascist. Being extreme left is the same as being communist. If one goes far enough to the extreme right, one comes out on the extreme left and vice-versa."

A clarification is necessary. These statements are somewhat misleading and can be viewed as a rendition of the continuance of the horseshoe thesis in political theory postulated by the French philosopher Jean-Pierre Faye (1925-20XX) in his book *Le Siècle des ideologies*.⁹ It is presented in the following image:



Horseshoe theorists argue that the <u>extreme left</u> and the <u>extreme right</u> are closer to each other than either is to the political center.

However, neither the rendition above nor the image and the explanation of the image are correct. The more exact, logical continuance is that being fascist is the same as being leftist. If a leftist faces reality, the leftist encounters the mirror image of fascism. If the fascist faces reality, the fascist encounters the mirror image of leftism.

In 1914, Benito Mussolini (1883-1945, dictator of Italy from 1922-1943) founded the Italian *Fasci Italiani di Combattimento*, (FIC, Italian Fasci of Combat), until 1919 called *Fasci d'Azione Rivoluzionaria*, (FAR, Fasci of Revolutionary Action). It was a merger of two other movements: the *Fasci d'Azione Internazionalista* and a previous political group that Mussolini had started called the *Fasci Autonomi d'Azione Rivoluzionaria*. A year later in 1915 the members began to officially refer to themselves as *Fascists*. ¹⁰ They were Italy's form of communism and communists. They were the Leftists.

The truth is that fascism, of which Hitler's National Socialism¹¹ is an offshoot, is communist and communism is fascist/National Socialist, i.e., the (extreme) political left **is** the (extreme) political right and vice-versa.

In the United States of America, the traditional political view of the Left is a Big Government what will solve all of the problems of the citizens; indeed, even illegal non-citizens. This is the same political view of fascism: a gargantuan government. It is a state religion that

"assumes the organic unity of the body politic and longs for a national leader attuned to the will of the people (who have been propagandized and brainwashed into wanting a certain will that has been dictated to them). It is totalitarian in that it views everything as political and holds that any action by the state is justified to achieve the common good. It takes responsibility for all aspects of life, including our health and well-being, and seeks to impose the uniformity of thought and action, whether by force or through regulation and social pressure. Everything,

including the economy and religion, must be aligned with its objectives. Any rival identity is part of the 'problem' and therefore defined as the enemy. ... Contemporary American liberalism embodies all of these aspects of fascism."¹²

This is totally contradictory to the opposite freedom symbolized by the statement *That government is best which governs least*.

The terms *political left* and *political right* have their origins in the French Revolution of 1789. Members of the French National Assembly who supported the monarchy sat on the right side of the president of the French National Assembly and those who supported the revolution sat on the left side of the president of the French National Assembly. In reality, the French Monarchists and the French Radicals were not at opposite ends of the political spectrum as historians would like us to believe. They were both on the same side with different approaches concerning how France was to be governed. The Monarchists wanted to place all power in one individual. The radicals wanted to invest all power in one big government oligarchy. The Monarchists and the Radicals were simply rival groups in the leftist political bloc.

The governing system of the political left is communism (collectivism, socialism), also called Marxism, and in its general use means

"a theory or system of social organization in which all property is owned by the community and each person contributes and receives according to their ability and needs."

The Oxford Dictionary explains communism as that system

"established by the Bolsheviks after the Russian Revolution of 1917, and it has generally been understood in terms of the system practised by the former Soviet Union and its allies in eastern Europe, in China since 1949, and in some developing countries such as Cuba, Vietnam, and North Korea. In this form of communism, it was held that the state would wither away after the overthrow of the capitalist system. In practice, however, the state grew to control all aspects of communist society. Communism in eastern Europe collapsed in the late 1980s

and early 1990s against a background of failure to meet people's economic expectations, a shift to more democracy in political life, and increasing nationalism such as that which led to the break-up of the Soviet Union."¹³

The definition of the governing system of the political right has come to mean fascism/National socialism (conservativism, rightism) and in its general use means "extreme right-wing, authoritarian, or intolerant views or practices."

The Oxford Dictionary explains fascism as follows:

the "totalitarian, right-wing, nationalist regime of Mussolini in Italy (1922–43); the regimes of the Nazis in Germany and Franco in Spain were also Fascist. Fascism tends to include a belief in the supremacy of one national or ethnic group, a contempt for democracy, an insistence on obedience to a powerful leader, and a strong demagogic approach."¹⁴

Often being associated with liberals, the welfare state, and anti-free market, the term left-wing has historically been applied to so-called extreme movements including communism, socialism, and anarchism.¹⁵

Often being associated with conservatives, monarchists, and traditionalists, the term right-wing has historically been applied to so-called extreme movements including fascists, nationalist-socialists, and racialists.¹⁶

These positions of the so-called political left (communism, left-wing) and the so-called political right (fascism/National Socialism, right-wing) were the accepted positions of the general public and academics throughout the last

seventy years of the twentieth century and have carried over into the twentyfirst century. The intent was then to deceive and still is to deceive.

It is exactly at this presentation of the definitions juncture that the fluidity of what fascism is and to which political pole it belongs becomes muddied, intentionally muddied. It was muddied at its inception, stayed muddied throughout the remainder of the twentieth century and to this day is still muddied in the first fifteen years of the twenty-first century. As long as leftists are intellectually incapable of comprehending that fascism is leftism, the clarity of what fascism is will remain muddy.

The instigator of the formulation of the deception intended to deceive the general public that has been followed by Leftists ever since was Joseph Stalin (1879-1953). Josef Stalin contemplated communism as a world movement. Benito Mussolini (1883-1945) and Adolf Hitler (1889-1945) envisioned their other-named forms of communism as national movements that would turn into international political movements which would eventually conquer the world.

Joseph Stalin (1879-1953, Leader of the Communist Party of the Soviet Union and dictator of the USSR 1924-1953) accepted the view that social democracy was a twin brother of fascism; both depended on each other. This was recognized by the world communist movement. When Stalin gained control of political power in the Soviet Union after the death of Lenin (Vladimir Ilyich Ulyanov, 1870-1924; head of government of the Russian Republic from 1917 to 1918, of the Russian Soviet Federative Socialist Republic from 1918 to 1924, and of the Soviet Union from 1922 to 1924), Stalin's policy on Soviet social economics shifted, thus intensifying class struggle within the Soviet Union. The peasants, particularly the wealthy *kulacks* (independent farmers) were perceived as enemies of the Communist Party of the Soviet Union. They were seen as wreckers and traitors of the system. This was carried over into international communism and as a result Stalin denounced social democrats and dissidents. He termed them fascists.

Under the leadership of the German Chancellor Hermann Müller (1876-1931, Chancellor 1920, 1928-1930), the Social Democratic Party (SPD) of Germany agreed with the emerging anti-communist parties that "red equals brown." The SPD passed repressive legislation against the Communists and upon the shooting of Communist demonstrators in Berlin on May 1, 1929, the Communists were convinced that Social Democrats were "Social Fascists." Nevertheless, in 1931, the Communist Party of Germany (KPD) labeled the NSDAP (*Nationalsozialistische Deutsche Arbeiterpartei*) "working people's comrades." These two groups formally united and attempted to defeat the SPD government in an ensuing election, denying any differences between Nazism and Social Democracy. 20

After the Nazis came to power in Germany, the KPD was outlawed and thousands of its members were arrested and sent to concentration camps. Joseph Stalin then abandoned all connections with social fascism.

In spite of the fact that Benito Mussolini once said that Joseph Stalin was "his very best student,"²¹ Joseph Stalin viewed Benito Mussolini and Adolf Hitler, as well, as deviators from his form of communist ideology as a world movement. Stalin labelled them rightist reactionaries. The naming was intentional. Thus, the groups of the political left and the political right came into being because Stalin's nomenclature separated them from their common origin. The division became history. After World War II it was vogue to consider them as separate, political ideologies. However, in fact they were both the same: communism was fascism/National Socialism and fascism/National Socialism was communism. This original reality has been

lost in the historical usages and transitions of the terms.²² Yet, the truth remains that the political left is fascism and fascism is the political left.

Jim O'Neill, essayist and regular contributor to the *Canada Free Press*, has written very clear essays explaining the rationale behind leftism and fascism: that there is no difference between fascism and leftism.²³

The Italian journalist Oriana Fallaci (1929-2006) in her book *The Force* of Reason (La Forza della Ragione) describes fascism and communism as two soccer teams opposing each other, yet in fact playing for the same side.

"... when I say Right and Left I do not refer to opposite and irreconcilable entities. One the symbol of regression and the one the symbol of progress. I refer to the adverse political sides which, like two soccer teams struggling for the World Cup, chase the ball of Power. Which by reciprocal kicking, elbowing, kneeling and other kinds of perfidiousness try to get it. So they really seem opposite and reconcilable entities. If you look at them closely, though, you realize that despite the different colours of their shorts and their shirts they are not even two separate entities; they are a homogeneous block. A single team fighting itself."²⁴

A few pages on in the book she says, "I curse myself for not having understood it earlier: for having let myself be fooled by the two soccer teams for so long." Americans should also curse themselves because they have been fooled throughout the twentieth century and into the twenty-first century by the Democratic Party with silence from the Republican Party, which have contributed to the dumbing down of the American citizen.



Playing for the same side can also be visualized by using the image of the Möbius band, a non-orientable, ruled surface with only one side and only one boundary. Anyone can make a Möbius band by taking a paper strip, giving it a half-twist, and then joining the ends of the strip to form a loop. The size of the Möbius band for this presentation is irrelevant. It is important that the reader keep in mind that the Möbius band is only one strip with only one side that allows two separate items to come together on the same plane.

In this exercise consider the Möbius band to be the political spectrum and the designates **leftism** and **fascism** to be ideologies in that spectrum. Fascism is not right wing! Fascism is left wing! Since Stalin's designation of the nomenclature, the left has successfully labelled conservativism as being fascist to take attention away from their own political sorcery.

If one follows the direction of **leftism**, one will come out in **fascism**. If one follows the direction of **fascism**, one will come out in **leftism**. At one and the same time **leftism** and **fascism** are the same on the same ideological plane in the political spectrum.

Making the Case that Hillary Clinton is a Fascist

In the June 22, 1995 issue of The New York Review of Books there appeared an essay by the Italian author-philosopher Umberto Eco (1932-2016) titled *Ur-Fascism*. ²⁶ In the essay Umberto Eco lists 14 characteristics that apply to what he calls *ur-fascism* (original fascism). I have edited and adapted these 14 characteristics to meet the needs of explaining them with respect to Hillary Clinton. Furthermore, while Umberto Eco comments on them as they apply to the male leader, who is *machismo*, I have commented on them as they apply to the female fascist Hillary Diane Rodham Clinton (1947-20XX).

1. The cult of tradition. Fascism in America was initially clothed in the term progressivism, which was established by the social workers in Chicago, Illinois Jane Addams (1860-1932) and Ellen Gates Starr (1859-1940) with their establishment of Hull House in 1889. This movement attracted social philosophers like John Dewey (1859-1952) and George Herbert Mead (1863-1931), journalists like Lincoln Joseph Steffens (1866-1936) and Ida Minerva Tarbell (1857-1944), novelists like Upton Sinclair 1878-1968) who authored The Jungle (1906), poets like Vachel Lindsay (1879-1931) and Carl Sandberg (1878-1967), historians like Charles Austin Beard (1874-1948) and Frederick Jackson Turner (1861-1932), artists and educators like Robert Henri (1865-1939), social scientists like Richard Theodore Ely (1854-1943), politicians like Robert La Follette (1855-1925) and Brand Whitlock (1869-1934).

The progressive movement produced these American Presidents: Theodore Roosevelt (1858-1919, President 1901-1909), William Howard Taft (1857-1930, President 1909-1913), Woodrow Wilson (1856-1924, President 1913-1921), and Franklin Delano Roosevelt (1882-1945, President 1933-1945). Progressive ideas were carried on in the Great Society of Lyndon Baines Johnson (1908-1973, President 1963-1969). In the 1970s there appeared progressive crusaders

like Ralph Nader (1934-20XX) and Charles Reich (1928-20XX) with his 1971 book *The Greening of America*.

Each participant in American progressivism [read American (liberal) fascism] had messages that contained bits of wisdom that indicate an accepted version of the fascist truth. These bits of truth are syncretized into the fascist truth. As a consequence, because the truth has already been stated, there is only allowance for interpretation but there is no advancement in the learning.

The Left in America see Hillary Clinton as the fulfillment of their hopes. She has established fascist themes and goals as main aspects of American liberalism. She is the feminine flank of fascism who theorizes that being fascist is being virtuous.

Hillary Clinton has kept the tradition by adapting herself to the rhetoric of American political movements: progressive youth, progressive women, and antiwar. In her commencement address at Wellesley College (1969) she laid out what she considered a worthy future: extermination of limitations to achieve new identities and ministering the correct political goals to society.²⁷


Hillary Clinton aligned herself early with the Chicago protestor and author Saul Alinsky (1909-1972). His *Rules for Radicals* (1971) became the script for revolutionary change undertaken not only by her, but by Barack Hussein Obama (1961-20XX, President 2009-2016), as well. Her graduating thesis was based on Alinsky's ideas which are decidedly fascistic: *There Is Only One Fight: An Analysis of the Alinsky Model* (1969).

At Yale University, she wrote articles for the *Yale Review of Law and Social Action*, some of them calling for the murder of policemen, others supporting the Black Panthers in their racial separation movement. For her activity as a warrior for social justice, she was offered a summer internship by lawyer Robert Treuhaft (1912-201), a member of the American Communist Party, Berkeley, California. Instead she went to Washington, D.C. where she worked as a legal consultant to

the impeachment inquiry staff of the House Committee on the Judiciary during the Watergate scandal, which culminated in the resignation of President Richard Milhous Nixon (1913-1994, President 1969-1974) in August 1974. After failing the District of Columbia bar exam, but passing the Arkansas bar exam, she made the decision to Marry Bill Clinton (1946-20XX, President 1993-2001) in Fayetteville, Arkansas.

In Arkansas, she began writing on fascist ideas about the state's responsibility to children and the family. For her the state sets the children free. Moreover, for her *political meaning* is *political action and the fascist transformation of the society.* This fascist agenda developed into book form with *It Takes A Village:* And Other Lessons Children Teach US, the village being the concept of collectivism where everything is managed by the state.²⁸

Indeed, if there is no need of management, then fascists will create a crisis that can be managed by the state, which will provide home inspectors, government advisors, and government social workers will treat society's illnesses and cure them. Thus, fascism is tyranny at its nicest!

- 2. The rejection of modernism is an aversion to the truth. In modernism, there are goals that are objective and knowable, particularly via scientific empiricism, not through divine revelation. Modernism is the search for the truth. The fascist Hillary Clinton undermines the truth in a number of ways: she makes arguments abstract, she utters absurd comments, she conducts herself and dresses in anticonservative fashion. Hillary Clinton does not tell the truth. She goes all out to avoid a falsehood and thus she does not say anything that is untrue. Her statements are aimed not at contradicting a truth, but at scoring her own vision of the truth as the vivid reality. Hillary Clinton deceives because she knows that is the only method to avoid the reality of truth.
- 3. *Irrationalism*. Hillary Clinton's irrationalism is shown in her attempts to undermine reason. She questions the use of philosophical reasoning in political situations. Irrationalism has its roots in the nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. The philosophy says that human life can be richer by expanding it beyond its rational dimensions with instinct, will over reason, and taking action for the sake of taking action so that a life philosophy can come into being. A prime example is William James (1842-1910), a progressive who argued that ideas cannot be expressed in logical terms, but only with regard to action that will show practical results, which will be truth as a result of feelings and actions termed radical freedoms and revolt. There is a distrust of intellectualism. In her speeches, the fascist Hillary Clinton attacks the modern culture with the use of *I* and verbs that signify strong action: *I will do more ..., I'm going to ..., I do have to..., I know how ..., I'll do everything I can ..., I took them on. I will eliminate barriers that stand in the way.*
- Anti-analytical criticism. For the fascist Hillary Clinton, disagreement with her politics is against fascist knowledge and, therefore, disagreement is treason to her.

- 5. Anti-diversity. Hillary Clinton seeks consensus on everything that she undertakes. She demands that those who support her must support her because if they refuse to support her they are different and have different views. In short, they are infiltrators in her movement and most probably, they are traitors to the movement.
- 6. *Individual and social frustration*. Hillary Clinton's political goals are based on the frustrations of individuals and social groups. She claims the middle class, the students, the African-Americans, the Hispanics and all deplorable persons are frustrated with their lives and she pledges to give them meaning with her fascist goals that are expressed as follows:
 - "I'll crush the opposition press"
 - "We are going to take things away from you on behalf of the common good."
 - ➤ "It's time for a new beginning, for an end to government of the few, by the few, for the few, and to replace it with shared responsibility for shared prosperity."
 - "We can't just let business as usual go on, and that means something has to be taken away from some people."
 - > "We have to build a political consensus and that requires people to give up a little bit of their own turf in order to create this common ground.
 - > "I certainly think the free market has failed."
 - > "I think it's time to send a clear message to what has become the most profitable sector in the entire economy, that they are being watched."
 - "What I want to do is take those profits and apply them to alternative energy."
 - "I really believe that it takes a village to raise a child."
 - ➤ "I also believe that every new handgun sale or transfer should be registered in a national registry."²⁹
- 7. **Obsession with a plot**. Hillary Clinton has nightmares that her supporters will believe the Clintons have committed murder, that she has a secret lesbian love affair with Huma Abedin, that she covered up the truth about Benghazi, that she has a double who is used to conceal her

health problems, that she has had secret contacts with illegal aliens to whom she will offer amnesty, that she intentionally sold her influence as Secretary of State for millions of dollars – all of these in spite of the fact that there is serious documentation that they are all true.

8. The followers must feel humiliated by the ostentatious wealth and force of their enemies. Hillary Clinton alludes that she is not rich and is not power hungry. Yet, the truth is that the Clintons are rich because being rich and wielding political power at all costs were their goals in life. Their political lives were networked to achieve these aims. They want political power and money for themselves, not for the American citizen. Receiving money for the Clinton Foundation, a ruse that claims to do good for poor people, really makes the Clinton's feel good. Everything the Clintons have undertaken in life to achieve political power and receive money, money, and more money, has bordered on illegality, of which their pay-to-play schemes are symbolical. Supporting Hillary Clinton in her candidacy for the Presidency are billionaire Republicans; the five largest money backers of the Clinton campaign are Jews.³⁰ The Clintons do not use their own money for political campaigning. They claim that it is not their money, but that it belongs to the Clinton Foundation, which is a charity for the world's poor.

Hillary Clinton argues that Americans are humiliated by the fear that Russia is stronger than America and that Russia must be forced to become a second-rate international power.

- 9. *Life is permanent warfare*. The fascist Hillary Clinton argues that war or a threat of war with Russia or with any other country must be a possibility because after such a solution to the world's problems there will be an age of peace.³¹
- 10. **Popular elitism**. The fascist Hillary Clinton is convinced that her supporters are the best types of American citizens. Those who are members of her political party

are even the best citizens. Hillary Clinton knows that her political power and the power of her political party needs dumb followers.³² Therefore, she and the Democratic Party have undertaken a dumbing down of American society, majorly since the end of World War Two. A present example of the dumbing down of the American citizenry is the institutionalization of the Common Core Educational Program in America's schools. Because Americans are dumb, they need to be led by the blessed leader Hillary Clinton. The mass dumbness is easily controlled by the political party and the government. Those who are party echelon leaders are inherently jealous of those above them and those below them because each echelon leader thinks s/he is elite. Some examples of Hillary Clinton's popular elitism are:

- 7. The Military Uniform Ban. According to Lieutenant Colonel Buzz Patterson, the man who carried President Clinton's nuclear football from 1996 to 1998, "Hillary did try to ban military uniforms in the White House and we objected for national security reasons. ... She relented only on the one point of those who were responsible for carrying the nuclear football. - **6. Gas Station Indians.** "I love this quote. It's from Mahatma Gandhi. He ran a gas station down in St. Louis for a couple of years. Mr. Gandhi, do you still go to the gas station? A lot of wisdom comes out of that gas station," she said at a 2004 fundraiser.
- **5. Allegedly Forcing Secret Service to Carry Her Bags.** According to MSNBC's Chris Matthews, he saw a Secret Service agent carrying around her bags in 2001. "Secret Service guys all around with those little ear phones and one large guy, rather embarrassed, rather sheepish, walking along with his own ear phones carrying her bags. Who who in the Senate

gets a Sherpa to carry their bags for them? ... I've never heard of a senator having a bag carrier." Ronald Kessler wrote in *A Matter of Character*, "Secret Service agents assigned at various points to guard Hillary during her campaign for the Senate were dismayed at how two-faced and unbalanced she was."

- **4. Abusing an Electrician.** Here's Kessler regarding Hillary's tenure in the White House: "When Hillary found a hapless White House electrician changing a lightbulb in the residence, she began screaming at him because she had ordered that all repair work was to be done when the First Family was out."
- **3. Not Exactly Showing Sympathy for the Homeless.** According to Tom Kuiper's *I've Always Been A Yankees Fan* (2006), Hillary confronted a homeless man in 2000. She said, "My name is Hillary Clinton. You going to vote in the primary?" He said yes, but that he needed money for food. A Clinton staffer gave him a voter registration card instead. When she stumbled on another homeless person during the same campaign, she asked if he would vote. He said he was homeless. Her reply: "Well, good for you."
- 2. Talking to Eleanor Roosevelt...But Not Jesus. According to Bob Woodward's book, *The Choice* (1996), Hillary used to chat with Eleanor Roosevelt and Mahatma (Mohandas Karamchand) Gandhi (1869-1948, via Jean Houston (1937-20XX), co-director of the Foundation for Mind Research. Houston inspired Hillary to write *It Takes a Village and Other Lessons Children Teach Us* and reportedly moved into the White House to help out. When asked if she wanted to address Jesus, however, she said it would be "too personal."
- 1. "What Difference...Does It Make?" Her dramatic lack of sympathy for the victims of the Benghazi attack and her own attempts to avoid culpability continue until today. She calls it the worst moment of her tenure

as Secretary of State but refuses to explain what she did wrong...or, indeed, what she did at all.³³

11. *Educate heroes and heroines*. One method of educating heroes and heroines is by using comics and children's books. Comics are necessary because Hillary Clinton's followers are dumbed down, but not so dumb that they cannot understand the message of comics. Children's books are necessary because they are read by children at an age when their minds and behaviors are formed. The following examples are typical.

Children's Books Promote Hillary More than 25 children's books aimed at kids as young as four years old have been published, singing Clinton's praises, since 1994, and several more are set to be released right after this month's Democratic convention. One book teaches kids how "tough as nails" Clinton single-handedly "paved the way for women everywhere." Jonah Winter, author of Hillary, stated that "by becoming president, she would demonstrate that a girl can grow up to be the most powerful person in the world. That's the world where I want to live. And this is a story I am thrilled to tell." Clearly, many other children's authors love to tell the same story.


The sheer volume of Pro-Hillary books marketed to children as young as four is appalling. At least 22 are currently on sale, and three more are set to be released the Democratic convention, making that number jump to a staggering 25 pro-Hillary children's books.

Like movies and TV, the propaganda publishing machine has been at it ever since the Clintons first entered in the Oval Office in the 90s. One kids' book, *Partners: Bill & Hillary*, published in 1994, teaches its readers about how the Clintons' partnership changed "the way we think about traditional roles, both in and out of the White House," setting up Hillary as more than just an average First Lady. Author Keith Elliot Greenberg also published a kid's book about same-sex parents in 1996.

The "inspiring" <u>Story of Hillary Rodham Clinton</u> praises the First Lady for her multiple roles of wife, mother, FLOTUS, and successful lawyer. T.J. Stacey openly displays his admiration for Clinton in <u>Hillary</u>

<u>Rodham Clinton: Activist First Lady</u>, and portrays her as a "symbol of American womanhood." Published in '97, <u>Hillary Rodham Clinton</u> also emphasizes the ways in which Hillary changed how Americans view the First Lady, and paints her as a talented, ambitious, and often humorous woman.




A picture book is no place to document the numerous affairs, scandals, and cover-ups that are a part of the Clintons' story. Instead, these books focus on Hillary as a trailblazer for women's rights everywhere. The cover of the comic book biography *Female Force: Hillary Clinton* portrays an art-rendering of Clinton posing superhero-esque in front of a waving American flag. The book is designed to prove why Clinton detractors are just wrong. The title of Michael Burgan's *Extraordinary Women: Hillary Clinton* betrays what his account of Clinton is like. You can bet Burgan doesn't call her "extraordinary" for the many crimes she hasn't been indicted for.

Hillary Rodham Clinton: Dreams Taking Flight is gushy, over-the-top Hillary-worship, even according to several reviewers. The <u>School Library Journal</u> acknowledged that "ardent Clinton supporters may relish this homage, but others probably would appreciate a more down-to-earth biography." The book was originally published at the end of Clinton's 2008 campaign, but was updated with info on her time as Secretary of State and re-released in 2015.

Because there can apparently never be too many Hillary books, the list has continued to grow in the midst of her 2016 campaign. <u>The Hillary Clinton Story: How a Girl with a Vision rose to the Center Stage</u>

<u>of the World</u> documents how Clinton "overcame obstacles of discrimination and prejudice" (as a white, upper-middle class Chicagoan) to become one of the top women leaders in the world. Author T.S. Lee also wrote *The Obama Story: The Boy With the Biggest Dream*.



Hillary Rodham Clinton: Some Girls Are Born to Lead is meant to instill girls ages 4-8 with "gender pride." The book doesn't really identify anything that Hillary has accomplished, but focuses on Clinton's identity as a female and a victim of a male-dominated world. The book tells its readers that "in the 1950s, it was a man's world" and that "only boys had no ceilings on their dreams." Enter spunky Hillary Clinton, dressed in a bright jumper, set against a gray and brown collection of famous men of the time, such as Jackie Robinson. Only liberals could get away with implying that black men Robinson and Nat King Cole had an easier time succeeding in life during the Civil Rights era than Hillary. Things weren't rosy for Hillary, because the poor girl was "criticized – in ways [people] would never criticize a man." But "tough as nails" Clinton single-handedly "paved the way for women everywhere." Susan B. Anthony (1820-1906) would probably disagree.

Hillary Clinton: The Life of a Leader, published in May 2016, is another released just in time for the election. It hypes on the many ways that Hillary is an excellent leader, from volunteering as a young child (never mind that many parents make their children volunteer at some point) to being a leader in college and become an accomplished attorney and president's wife. Hillary Rodham Clinton: Do All the Good You Can was written by Cynthia Levinson, who once lived across the hall from Clinton at Wellesley. It focuses on how Hillary has spent her life "working for good in the world."³⁴

Even though Hillary Clinton is a comic figure in these children's books, she has been transformed into someone the female youth in America should emulate and surely young, progressive females want to be like her.

Whether or not Hillary Clinton is ready to establish a heroine death cult and die for the American fascist cause remains to be seen, but I believe Hillary Clinton would surely not die for anything ... except money!

12. *The will to power can be transferred to sexual matters*. With regard to Hillary Clinton, we can say that in place of her illogical decisions on Libya, Egypt and The Muslim Brotherhood, and Syria, as well as other *faux pas* in international relations, she has transferred the attention of the American public onto the so-called and alleged sex escapades of her rival Donald Trump. All the while she has remained pure and innocent, symbolized by her white Mao pants suit that she wore during the third debate. It has been reported that Hillary Clinton "is a sex-crazed, 'evil,' prolifically 'polyamorous,' bisexual (or at least bi-curious), and 'ruthless power-hungry' supervillain, with a taste for criminal conspiracy and character assassination aimed at enemy 'bimbos.'"³⁵ She is reported to have had lesbian sex with Yoko Ono³⁶ and her alleged present lesbian lover is her advisor

Huma Abedin.³⁷ Of course (!), both are interested in lesbianism as a political statement rather than as a sexual relationship. There is also documentation that she has received sex appointments arranged by her fixer.³⁸

Sex is an easier game to play when you do not possess political power. Therefore, the will to power can be transformed into the will to sex.

- 13. *Selective populism*. The individual is not important for Hillary Clinton. Political power lies in the collective population that is led by the perfect leader who intrinsically knows what the people desire. Individuals do not have a political will. Only the collective of citizens plays the role of having a political will that the leader knows. Only the fascist leader, Hillary Clinton represents the people.³⁹
- 14. *The use of newspeak*. The fascist Hillary Clinton uses Newspeak, a language invented by George Orwell in his book *1984*, published in 1948. The language is used to place limits of critical reasoning and analysis. Examples of Hillary Clinton's Newspeak have been translated into understandable English.⁴⁰ To quote George Orwell Newspeak is "political language ... designed to make lies sound truthful and murder acceptable."⁴¹ Other examples are:

"Rights were once based on law and conformity to an accepted 'human standard of truth, propriety or justice' but have become

entitlements, primarily based upon one's membership in a particular aggrieved group (racial, ethnic, gender, etc.).

Laws were once *objective*, established, and applicable to all but are now *evolving*, subject to the whims of judges and politicians.

Morality was once based on settled moral or spiritual principles which were considered *absolutes*, whereas moral *relativism* has become so exalted that 'morality' is now defined as 'An ancient word used only by those on the wrong side of history.'

Tolerance once meant openly *permitting* a belief or action without constraint, but now *requires* 'acceptance, validation, and participation in that which you don't agree with.' "⁴²

Allied to Newspeak is the use of doublethink and doublespeak, essentially believing in two contradictory matters at the same time. Some examples of doublethink are:

- affirmative action.
- Democracy as practiced in the USA is another example of 'doublethink', that we espouse democracy overseas but do not practice it at home.
- forced busing.
- free education.
- free healthcare.
- homosexual marriage.
- Hundreds of girls have been raped or molested, but of course the real victims are the refugees.
- Judicial constraint is a constant example of doublethink.
- minority quotas.

- No political programs have a success rating but each political party will tell you that their program is good for you.
- When the Court systems sends an innocent man to prison for 30 years, and decades later that man is cleared through DNA

evidence, the judges claim to be the victims of *judicial* constraint.

Here are some doublespeak statements and their explanations:⁴³

- > anti-Semitism (anti-Israel, anti-Jewish)
- bulk collection (mass surveillance)
- climate change denier (accusation against someone who is against the scam known as global warming)
- > collateral damage, (human deaths)
- conspiracy theories (used to criticize those who are searching for the truth)
- Department of Defense, Department of Homeland Security, Intelligence (department of war, department of control, spying)
- > eliminate, neutralize, depopulate (kill, murder)
- enhanced interrogation (another term for causing physical or mental pain during questioning, torture)
- ethnic cleansing (doesn't sound as evil as genocide)
- extra judicial killing (assassination)
- extremism, extremist (its broadness means governments and society can declare anyone to be extreme)
- freedom fighter, moderate rebel (mercenaries are freedom fighters? terrorists are moderate rebels?)
- globalism (the new world order [NOW] placing everything under one governing control)
- humanitarian intervention [an oxymoron], responsibility to protect
 [R2P] (intervention is invasion)
- negative cash flow (negative economic development)

- negative patient care (unsuitable patient care outcome resulting in death?)
- quantitative easing (devaluation of the currency and inflation)
- reasonable suspicion (probable cause as defined in the Fourth Amendment)
- sustainable development (control according to the policies of environmental political parties)
- war on terror (can be used to override human rights, the laws of nature)
- weapons of mass destruction (chemical and nuclear weapons)

Here are some doublethink/doublespeak statements pitted against each other:

- ➤ Be assertive. → Don't act like a bitch.
- ▶ Be masculine/manly.

 → Don't act tough and don't fight.
- ➤ Don't be a slut.

 Don't be frigid.
- ➤ Don't lie. → Don't say anything that's rude.
- ➤ Express yourself.

 Wear what is popular this season.
- ➤ Follow your dreams.

 Find a secure job.
- You must fit in.

 → You must stand out.
- You must work well as a team.

 → You must be a rugged individual.
- Your life is run by fate.

Nicht nur den Liberalismus des 18. und des 19. Jahrhunderts geben wir Schritt für Schritt auf, sondern

auch die Grundlagen der individualistischen Philosophie, die wir 'als Vermächtnis von Erasmus und Montaigne, von Cicero und Tacitus, von Perikles und Thukydides empfangen haben. ...

Das Wort Individualismus hat heute einen schlechten Klang, denn man bringt den Ausdruck in Zusammenhang mit Eigennutz und Selbstsucht. Aber der Individualismus, den wir dem Sozialismus und allen anderen Arten des Kollektivismus gegenüberstellen, braucht damit nichts zu tun zu haben. ... Dieser Individualismus, der auf der Grundlage des Christentums und der Philosophie des klassischen Altertums sich zuerst während der Renaissance voll entwickelte und sich seitdem immer mehr als abendländische Kultur entfaltet hat, ist in der Hauptsache durch die Achtung vor dem Individuum als Menschen gekennzeichnet. Das ist gleichbedeutend mit seiner Anerkennung Ansichten und Geschmackes als der letzten Instanz in seiner eigenen, wenn auch noch so begrenzten Sphäre und mit dem daß Entwicklung der individuellen Glauben. die und Neigungen des Menschen Begabungen wünschenswert ist. Das Wort "Freiheit" in allen seinen Bedeutungen ist so abgegriffen und so viel mißbraucht Worden, daß man sich scheut, es zur Bezeichnung der Ideale zu verwenden, die es in jener Zeit verkörperte."

"With raving speed we have distanced ourselves from not only the principles of Cobden and Bright, Adam Smith and Hume and even Locke and Milton, but also from the core of western culture which emanates from Christianity, Greek, and Roman elements. Not only are we abandoning the liberal thought of the 18th and 19th centuries, but also the bases of individualistic philosophy, which western civilization has received as a legacy from Erasmus and Montaigne, from Cicero and Tacitus, from Pericles and Thucydides.

Today the word *individualism* has a bad ring to it because one brings to the expression the connection with self-interest and egoism. But the individualism which we place in opposition to socialism and all other kinds of collectivism does not need to have anything to do with

them. ... This individualism, based on the teachings of Christianity and the philosophy of the classical antiquity, which fully developed first in the Renaissance, and since then which has unfolded itself as western civilization culture, has as its central issue the esteem of the individual person. This is synonymous with the recognition of its views and tastes as the last instance in its own belief, even with its own limited sphere and with the faith, that the development of individual talents and inclinations of the person is worthy of esteem. The word *freedom* in all of its meanings is so hackneyed and so much abused, that one dreads to use it as an ideal which it at one time embodied."⁴⁵

Western civilization and its culture is what it is because of individualism. Fascism is totalitarian collectivism. Fascism denies individuality. Hillary Clinton is fascist and denies individualism. Anyone who denies individualism denies western civilization and its culture.
